

For the past seven years Stephen Weeg has been the Executive Director for Health West, a community and migrant health center with six clinics in southeast Idaho. Previously, he was the Executive Director of Telehealth Idaho at the Institute of Rural Health, Idaho State University, owned a health and human service consulting firm, and was the CEO of the state psychiatric hospital. Weeg has a 38 year career in health and human services leadership in Idaho. Health West is a participant in a national safety net medical home initiative and moving all of its clinics to become certified by NCQA as patient centered medical homes. He has developed innovative community programs related to behavioral health, child abuse investigation and treatment, services for people with disabilities, and successful inter-agency community partnerships He has provided management consulting, strategic planning, and public dispute resolution to an array of state and community agencies and rural hospitals.

He is currently a member of the Executive Leadership Team for the Governor's Idaho Health Care Council and previously chaired the Governor's Select Committee on Health Care, which has studied and made recommendations to address quality, cost, and access to care in Idaho. He is also a member of the Portneuf Health Care Foundation Board, Pocatello Hospital, LLC Board, Idaho Health Quality Planning Commission, the Idaho Board of Health and Welfare, and the Idaho Health Data Exchange.

He has a bachelor's degree from the University of Notre Dame and an master's degree in Counseling from Idaho State University.
