**PURPOSE:** To offer financial assistance to NABIP IDAHO Leaders that are asked to attend NABIP meetings, actual incurred costs by member.

**POLICY:** The NABIP IDAHO Leaders will receive financial support to attend and travel to NABIP Capitol Conference, NABIP Region Meeting and NABIP Annual Convention.

## **PROCEDURE(S):**

- A. It is recommended that the NABIP IDAHO President, President-elect, Secretary Legislative Chair and Legislative Co-Chair (if any) attend NABIP's Capitol Conference. NABIP IDAHO will reimburse the early bird conference registration, reasonable and customary airfare and conference hotel expenses. Subject to available funds.
- B. It is recommended that the NABIP IDAHO President, President-elect and Secretary attend NABIP's Annual Convention / Regional meeting. NABIP IDAHO will reimburse the early bird conference registration, reasonable and customary airfare and conference hotel expenses. Subject to available funds.
- C. NABIP IDAHO will also budget additional money to assist other NABIP IDAHO leaders to attend NABIP's Capitol Conference and Annual convention / Regional meeting. Subject to available funds.
- **D.** NABIP IDAHO may also budget additional money to assist other NABIP IDAHO leaders to attend other meetings. NABIP IDAHO will reimburse \$500 for each State board member to attend Annual convention and Capitol conference. NABIP IDAHO will also reimburse \$500 per local chapter for Annual convention and Capitol conference. If the state reimburses a board member, the local chapter does not also receive reimbursement for that same person. Subject to available funds.
